EOCIL offers support programs designed to enhance **independence** for individuals with disabilities.



**Our services focus on empowerment, advocacy, and education tailored to meet diverse needs.**

## Our programs include:



**Independent Living:** We empower people with disabilities to lead self-directed lives through information and referral, skills training, peer support, advocacy, and transitional services.



**Health-Related Social Needs:** We offer support for housing, food access, transportation, and community connections to remove systemic barriers to health.



**LGBTQ2SIA+ Services:** We offer safe and affirming programs that advance equity, inclusion, and leadership for LGBTQ2SIA+ individuals across rural communities.



**PHEM (Public Health & Emergency Management):** We offer community-driven initiatives including food pantries, tree planting, Beekeeping, food distribution, cancer screenings, youth tobacco use prevention, well water testing, immunizations, and public health education.



**Housing Services:** We offer supported and transition housing services. We cultivate partnership with individuals and families to secure safe, stable housing with advocacy, resources, and long-term support.



**Harm Reduction:** We offer safer use supplies, overdose prevention tools, and supportive resources that reduce risks, promote safety, and connect people to care and treatment options if and when they choose.



**Mental Health & Wellness:** We offer inclusive and compassionate support that promotes resilience, dignity, and choice for people navigating mental health and substance use.



**HIV Community Services:** We offer peer-based Ryan White Case Management Services provide and comprehensive support for people living with HIV. Services consist of resource navigation, health insurance coordination, housing, transportation, food security, mental health services, and vocational support.



**HIV Outreach and Public Health:** We offer free testing so individuals know their status, reengages those out of care, and connects newly HIV diagnosed individuals to services and supports. We partner with providers and communities to deliver prevention tools, sexual health education, and the powerful message that Undetectable = Untransmittable (U=U), advancing End HIV Oregon and building healthier futures together.
